Back injuries from lifting tools	All	No	<p>Ensure everyone using tools has had adequate training and supervision.</p> <p>Ensure first aiders and adequate first aid kit is on site.</p> <p>Ensure tools are in good repair and are kept safely on site</p>	Yes
Slips and trips	All	No	<p>Make sure everyone is wearing correct footwear.</p> <p>Make sure pathways are clear</p> <p>Warn everyone if surface is uneven.</p> <p>Ensure first-aider and adequate first aid kit is on site.</p>	Yes

<p>Bitten injuries from lifting</p>	<p>All</p>	<p>No</p>	<p>Ensure everyone has had basic instruction in the correct use of gloves for manual handling.</p>	<p>Yes</p>
			<p>Ensure everyone using tools has had adequate training and supervision Check no-one with back problems does this.</p>	
<p>Bites and stings</p>	<p>All</p>	<p>No</p>	<p>Check for presence of bee and wasp nests before work starts and keep away from them. Make sure everyone's medical history is known and what action needs to be taken if they are allergic.</p>	<p>Yes</p>

Litter	All	No	Remove dangerous litter with a litter picker and gloves before the work starts.	Yes
